APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.



The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a)/30(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioners rather 200 liters of country made liquor, 4 pieces of Aluminium Pipe and 2000 liter Raw Java are said to have recovered from the place of occurrence. He further submits that petitioners have criminal antecedent of similar nature as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

Considering the facts that the petitioners are involved in manufacturing and selling of illegal liquor, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, their prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected in connection with Ganga Bridge P.S. Case No. 240 of 2021.
