3      01-11-2022                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and  
  
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case  
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a),  
32, 41, 56(a), 56(b) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 162 litres of Indian made  
foreign liquor from two vehicles. Two persons were  
apprehended from Omni vehicle. The petitioner is owner of  
the Swift Dzire vehicle who is alleged to have fled away  
from the place of seizure.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the  
petitioner is quite innocent and he was not apprehended



from the spot. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner has given his vehicle to one of the co-accused namely Ram Saw and he has misused the vehicle in question. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

The petitioner agrees to deposit Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousands) to the District Legal Services Authority, Lakhisarai.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-V-cum-Exclusive Special Court-2, Excise Act, Lakhisarai in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 54C2 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned court below on showing receipt of deposit of



Rs. 25,000 in favour of District Legal Services Authority,  
Lakhisarai.
