the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-I, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Bhagwan Bazar P.S. Case No. 141/2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
