2 14-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to

remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of

non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office

will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case

registered for the offence punishable under Sections 302,

120(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the

Arms Act.

Petitioner is said to have involved in committing a

murder of the deceased by making conspiracy and acting as a

liner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

petitioner is innocent, not named in the FIR and has been

falsely implicated in this case. He submits that during the



course of investigation the police had arrested the petitioner on suspicion but at the time of remand the learned Magistrate released him on P.R. Bond finding no material against the petitioner. He submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the informant has not expressed any doubts about the involvement of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mirganj P.S. Case No. 245 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
