On 22-07-2016, as per specific averment made in paragraph no. 19 of the writ petition, the petitioner presented his Service Appeal No.11 of 2016, challenging the orders of punishment dated 27-05-2016, before the Respondent No.2. The said specific assertion has not been denied or disputed by the respondents in their counter affidavit. The irresistible



conclusion, therefore, is that the appeal is pending for now at least 6 years.

In view of such submission, the application is disposed of with direction to the Principal Secretary, Department of Revenue and Land Reforms, Govt. of Bihar, Patna (Respondent No.2) to pass final order on the appeal within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
