2 19-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Govindpur P.S. Case No. 151 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 324, 504, 327 & 308/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this bail application on behalf of petitioner no.2, above named.

Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn as against petitioner no.2, above named.



Though allegation is there against the petitioner no.1 but, considering the fact that he is working in C.R.P.F. as constable, his bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioner no.1, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Nawada, in connection with Govindpur P.S. Case No. 151 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
