ORAL ORDER

- 3 02-08-2022 Though, the present writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of the notice dated 11.12.2017 issued under Section 3 of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act, 1956'), in connection with a Land Encroachment Case initiated against the petitioner, but it is the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner that without passing any order under Section 6(1) of the Act, 1956, a notice dated 29.12.2017 under Section 6(2) of the Act, 1956 has been issued, hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be granted liberty to file his show cause reply and the Circle Officer, Kishanganj i.e. the respondent no. 3, be directed to pass final order under Section 6(1) of the Act, 1956.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed



off with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate show cause reply in the aforesaid encroachment case, initiated against the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from today whereupon the respondent no.3 shall consider the same and pass final orders thereon under Section 6(1) of the Act, 1956 within a period of 12 weeks, thereafter.

It is needless to state that for a period of sixteen weeks from today, status quo existing as on today shall be maintained.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
