Petitioner is directed to file a representation before the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Employees



Provident Fund Office, Patna within four weeks from today. If such a representation is filed by the petitioner before the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Employees Provident Fund Office, Patna, he will consider and dispose of the same in accordance with law at the earliest. Thereafter if the petitioner has some grievance, he may file a fresh writ application.

With the aforesaid observation and direction, this application is dismissed.
