2 22-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Deo P.S. Case No. 23 of 2021 registered under Section
30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case due to village party politics.
Further submission is that on perusal of seizure list, it would be
evident that nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional District and Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Aurangabad in connection with Deo P.S. Case No. 23 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
