3 01-12-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- (a.) For issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the license of the petrol pump to the petitioner at the location within 4km from Sahu Jain High School, Mirganj towards Gopalganj on NH 85, Bihar, in spite of being selected as successful candidate after the draw of lots as notified by a mail dated 03.02.2019 from the Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited.



- (b.) For issuance of any appropriate Writ/Writs, directing the respondents to follow the rule for choosing the dealership of the general and rural retail outlet as mentioned in the advertisement dated 25.11.2018.
- (c.) For issuance of any relief/reliefs for which the Petitioner is entitled in the eye of law.

On 25.11.2022, we had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents states that the petitioner has suppressed material information inasmuch as joint inspection of the land took place on 15.03.2019, wherein petitioner was also present. Also, the land was found to be non- suitable, which fact was never disputed by the petitioner. This information stands suppressed by the petitioner.

None has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner. However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.

Even today, despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

As such, the present petition stands dismissed for default.
