The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a

case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 395, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that four unknown miscreants have

looted 250 grams of gold and 1.5 kgs of silver

ornaments of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the

petitioner that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R and

his name subsequently sprang up on the confessional

statement of co-accused Chunnu Kumar. Moreover, good



sense has prevailed between the parties and both the parties have compromised the matter.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st, Class, Raxaul at Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Adapur P.S. Case No. 17 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
