learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory

bail in connection with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 148 of 2020

registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325,

354-B, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in

this case the petitioners had executed bond under Section 41 of

the Cr.P.C. and therefore, their case may be disposed of in light

of the ratio laid down in the case of *Mahendra Prasad Singh*

vs. the State of Bihar reported in *2004(3) PLJR 491*.



Considering the aforesaid, this anticipatory bail application is disposed of with a direction to the Court below that when the petitioners appear and pray for bail after submission of the chargesheet, it may be treated as their first appearance and pass order in light of the aforesaid decision of Mahendra Prasad Singh (Supra).
