2 12-10-2022 Heard Mr. Prafull Chandra Jha, learned counsel for
the petitioner.

2. The petitioner has moved the Court seeking recall
of order dated 25.10.2018 by which CWJC No. 1667 of 2015
was dismissed for non prosecution.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on
the said day inadvertently, the list could not be marked and thus
he could not appear leading to dismissal of the writ petition.

4. Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and
going through the averments made in the writ petition, the Court
finds that sufficient cause has been shown for non appearance of
learned counsel for the petitioner on 25.10.2018 when CWJC
