2 15-11-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“1. That the present writ application is being
filed for a direction upon the concerned respondents
to take measurement of the admitted additional
works done by the petitioner in pursuance of
recommendation made by the junior Engineer and
Assistant Engineer that the petitioner had done the
additional work and payment may be made to him up



to that extent.

Also for the direction to the respondent to issue completion certificate relating to admitted additional work done by the petitioner in pursuance of recommendation made by the Junior Engineer and Assistant Engineer and the information given by the department to the petitioner under RTI Act.

Also for any other relief or reliefs to which this Hon'ble Court finds the petitioner entitled to.”

In view of the fact that Bihar Public Works Dispute Arbitration Tribunal is now functional, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, before the appropriate forum/Tribunal, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six months from the date of institution.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.



The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with
the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall stand
disposed of.
