Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 1st, East Muzaffarpur in connection with Kajimohammadpur P.S. Case No.276 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
