2 28-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304(B) and 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and ¾ of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioners are said to have tortured the deceased for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry for a cash of Rs. 2,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this



case. He submits that petitioner no.1 is the mother-in-law of the deceased and petitioner no.2 is married Nanad of deceased and husband of the deceased is already in judicial custody. He submits that there is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioners. He further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that husband of the deceased is already in judicial custody, let the above named petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 988 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
