ORAL ORDER

2 28-09-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered u/s 8, 20(b)(ii)(B) and 25 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and co-accused tried to flee away but they were arrested. On search, five kgs **Ganja** was recovered from the bag of the petitioner namely Ranjan Kumar Gupta and five kgs **Ganja** was also recovered from the bag of the co-accused.



Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to local politics. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 20.11.2021.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner by submitting that five kgs ***Ganja*** was recovered from the possession of the petitioner which is more than small quantity but less than commercial quantity.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of detention, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail ***after framing of charge*** on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Aurangabad in connection with Amba P. S. Case No. 198 of 2021.
