2 29-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Sadar Vaishali P.S. Case no. 343 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 41(1), 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Prosecution case relates to recovery of total 268.92 liters illicit country made liquor from a Bolero vehicle bearing Registration No. BR06P9757 which belongs to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has got no criminal antecedent. It is admitted fact that the petitioner is registered owner of the said bolero vehicle



in question but which is used for commercial use. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery of illicit liquor.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail and submitted that the petitioner is owner of the bolero vehicle from where the recovery has been made.

The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs 30,000/- (Thirty Thousand) in the District Legal Services Authority of concerned District.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Sadar Vaishali P.S. Case no. 343 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Excise Judge-II, Vaishali at Hajipur subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned court below on showing the receipt of deposit of Rs.



30,000/- (Rs. Thirty thousand) by the petitioner in the account
of the concerned DLSA.
