ORAL ORDER

3 19-07-2022 After some arguments, the learned Senior counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present petition but seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to seek redressal of his grievances regarding right, title and possession over the land in question appertaining to Khata no. 721, Plot no. 294 measuring an area of 8 Bigha 3 Katha 5 Dhurs situated at Mauza Barhoga Jadu Tola Sirisiya, Thana no. 15, Anchal-Goriakothi, District- Siwan, before the learned court below.
