Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That the present writ application is being filed for quashing of the letter dated 09.05.2022, issued under the signature of Branch Manager, Canara Bank, Harrakh Branch, Begusarai, whereby the request of the petitioner for granting 5 years time in liquidating the rest amount to the tune of Rs. 61,79,620/- [After depositing Rs.15,00,000/- as per the direction contained in Order dated 07.03.2022, passed in CWJC

No. 1134 of 2022, (Smt. Ragni Kumar Vs. Chairman Canara Bank and Ors)], has been negated and only three months time has been given to liquidate the aforesaid amount by paying equated monthly installments, without appreciating the facts as well as circumstances in which the petitioner is in, since the original loanee i.e., husband of the petitioner died on 27.04.2021.

In view of the fact that Debts Recovery Tribunal is now functional, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to such other appropriate remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

As and when any such request is made by the petitioner before the Tribunal or the respondent-bank, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also

stand disposed of.
