ORAL ORDER

3 19-07-2022 The petitioner has prayed for grant of J.P. Samman Pension. It is submitted that case of the petitioner has not been considered by the concerned authorities and the same is pending consideration.

The learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that appropriate decision shall definitely be taken in the case of the petitioner within a fixed time frame, however, since the petitioner was not detained under Defense of India Rules (D.I.R.) or Maintenance of Internal Security Act (M.I.S.A.), his claim has



not been considered.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to the concerned authority to decide the claim of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law as also in accordance with the Scheme in question, within a period of eight weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
