That this is an application for grant of an appropriate writ for a direction to the respondents to give effect to "Bihar Centenary Leprosy Welfare Scheme" of the Directorate of Social Security and Disability under Social Welfare Department, State of Bihar and to implement the same and to provide monetary and other assistance as mentioned in the Scheme to the Lepers of Visible Deformities (Grade-II).

In view of the affidavit dated 15.11.2021, filed on behalf of the State, we find the respondents to have taken appropriate action in accordance with law.
