4 02-08-2022 After some argument, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to challenge the order dated 16.07.2018 passed in Arms License Case No. 430 of 2010 by the District Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara, by filing appropriate appeal, however, seeks a direction upon the appellate authority to consider all the issues to be raised by the petitioner in the said appeal and also decide the same on merits.
