APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323 307, 504 and 354/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault upon the informant side by the accused persons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner has not been arrested at the spot. He further submits that the injuries are simple in nature.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Sheikhpura in connection with Ariyari P.S. Case No. 106 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
