This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Baheri P.S. Case No. 60 of 2019 (G.O. Case No.358 of 2019) for the offence punishable under Sections 467, 468, 420 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought on record an order dated 22.11.2021 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 4426 of 2021, by which similarly situated co-accused namely, Ashish Jha @ Kinshu Jha @ Ashish Kumar Jha, has been granted anticipatory bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

For the reasons recorded in the order dated

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his
his arrest/surrender within ten weeks from today in the Court
below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.

Judge-cum-Special Judge (Excise Act), Darbhanga, in
connection with Baheri P.S. Case No. 60 of 2019 (G.O. Case
NO. 358 of 2019), subject to the conditions as laid down under
Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
