Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ and/ or order and/ or direction commanding the respondents to provide disturbance free land to the petitioner so that the petitioner can execute the agreement no. 98F2/18-19 for construction of Community Hall at Siarua village in Siarua Gram Panchayat under Barauli Block, Gopalganj.

The petitioner also seeks a direction to respondents to extend the agreement no. 98F2/18-19 without any penalty for execution of the abovesaid agreement.

The petitioner further seeks a direction to respondents for completion of work allotted to the petitioner as per agreement.

OR

In alternative to above, the petitioner be compensated by the respondents for the loss due to non execution of agreement as there is no fault on the part of the petitioner in execution of the agreement.

In view of the fact that Bihar Public Works Dispute Arbitration Tribunal is now functional, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the



present petition with liberty to take recourse to such other appropriate remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

As and when any such request is made by the petitioner before the Tribunal, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
