APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Hajipur Sadar P.S. Case no. 69 of 2020 instituted for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Prosecution case relates to recovery of 1886.13 litres of IMFL from the land of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The alleged land is a joint property. He has got no criminal antecedent. Neither the petitioner was arrested on spot nor any incriminating article has been



recovered from his conscious and constructive possession.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration that the alleged land belongs to the petitioner, from where recovery of illegal liquor has been made, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner and, as such, his application for bail is rejected.
