Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of
non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will
place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323,
324, 307, 504, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner along with other accused persons are said to
have assaulted the informant as a result of which he received
injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. He submits that though there is specific allegation against



the petitioner to assault the informant by means of iron rod but the injury found upon the victim is simple in nature. He submits that there is case and counter case in between the parties and both sides have sustained injury. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the injury found upon the victim is simple in nature, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No. 341 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
