2 23-05-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.100 of 2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the owner of the truck in question and he is not supposed to travel with the truck for loading goods that is the duty of the driver and the transport agency.

Considering the same, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.



Accordingly, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.100 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
