The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 293 of 2002 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406/409/419/420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is of not completing the work of less than Rupees Five Thousand and he is ready to deposit the amount of Rs. 5000/- in the account of B.D.O. Sheikhpura. He



also submits that the petitioner is working in Punjab National Bank and because of this case his entire career will suffer.
