6 19-09-2022 Though the present writ petition was filed for grant of death-cum-retiral dues, however, during the interregnum period, most of the death-cum-retiral dues of the petitioner has stood paid and as far as grant of family pension is concerned, it has been stated by the learned counsel for the Respondent-Municipal Corporation that the same is not payable, but, the same is refuted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

In such view of the matter, the present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the



petitioner to approach the Municipal Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Madhubani and in case, appropriate representation is filed with regard to her subsisting grievances, the same shall be considered, in accordance with law and disposed of within a period of eight weeks, thereafter.
