Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



- (I) For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing all the respondents authorities to enquiry the matter <sup>in</sup> regard to misused and looted the huge amount of government money, which was sanctioned to prepare the road in period of flood in the District of Gopalganj, Block Baikunthpur in the year 2020 and further direct to respondent to take strict action on pursuance of Right to Information Act and said information has not given to petitioner.
- (II) For issuance of direction to take an appropriate action against respondent No. 5 (Executive Engineer) who is not giving the information regarding flood period during 2020 in the District of Gopalganj Block Baikunthpur and further direct to take action against authorities who are guilty of misused/looted the huge amount of government money.
- (III) For any other relief/reliefs as the petitioner is entitled in law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition, with better particulars, on the same and subsequent cause of action, if so required and



desired.

Permission granted with liberty as prayed for.
