“For issuance of writ, especially in nature of certiorari, to set aside the order contained in Memo No.- 636 dated 15/04/2019 issued under the signature of District Agriculture Officer, Munger, whereby he cancelled the work order dated 26/02/2019 to supply some article and further forfeiting the earnest money of petitioner issued work order in favour of M/s Basant



Bihar to supply the same.

Further prayer is to direct the respondents authorities to allow the petitioner to supply the aforesaid articles in pursuance of aforesaid work order dated 29/02/2019, which the petitioner is ready to supply the same within a week if he is allowed.”
