2 20-08-2022 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Pipra P.S.
Case No. 334 of 2021 registered for the offence under Sections
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and is in
custody since 31.12.2021.

The allegation against the petitioner is to be engaged
in illegal trading/manufacturing of illicit liquor, where, there is
recovery of 731.4 litres of IMFL/country made liquor from the
alleged Pick Up Van.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submitted that the name of the petitioner surfaced on the basis



of disclosure made by one co-accused, namely, Rajesh Kumar and admittedly, nothing surfaced from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner, who is a man of clean antecedent. While concluding the argument, it has been submitted that investigation has been completed, for which, charge-sheet has been submitted, as such, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence.

Learned APP opposes the prayer of bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances as mentioned above, as recovery of illicit liquor was not made from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner, who is a man of clean antecedent coupled with the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 334 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, (Court No.-1), Supaul/concerned court, subject to the conditions as mentioned under Section 437 (3) of the Cr.P.C.
