Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that calculation of arrears of rent as indicated in the notices issued to the petitioners, is erroneous.

The petitioners shall be at liberty to raise the aforesaid aspect in their representation before Zila Parishad. If the petitioners file representation within four weeks from today, Zila Parishad shall be required to consider the same and pass a reasoned order within four weeks thereafter.

We make it clear that we have not gone into the merits of the petitioners' contention as raised in the writ petition.

This application stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and observations made hereinabove.
