ORAL ORDER

3 19-12-2022 Heard the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove
the defects within four weeks.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Complaint Case No.C-165 of 2022, registered for the offences
punishable u/s 498-A, 323, 504, 379 of IPC and $\frac{3}{4}$ of Dowry
Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the O.P. No.2 submits that there is a
compromise between the parties.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case,
since there is a compromise between the parties, let the above



named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in Complaint Case No.C-165 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
