2 29-11-2022 Petitioners have prayed for the following relief(s):-

“(i) For issuance of writ of mandamus
upon the authorities of the District Health
Society, Saran to issue fresh work order in
favour of the petitioners who are lowest rate
quoter L1 and L2 in tender of work of



outsourcing and in pursuance of direction sought by the District Health Society, Saran the State Health Society, Bihar, Patna issued instruction on 20-8-2018 clarifying there-in that the District Health Society itself competent to issue work order on favour of the petitioners being L1 and L2 and even Hon'ble High Court in C.W.J.C. No. 16683/2017 filed by the petitioners directed the District Magistrate-cum-Chairman of the District Health Society, Saran on to decide the petitioners claim.

(ii) For holding that the observation made in the proceeding of the Governing Body of the District Health Society Saran on 29-01-2019 with regard to averment on made in letter No. 3947 dated 20-8-2018 is contrary to the factual matrix of the case as well as the order passed in C.W.J.C. No. 16683/2018 on 9-5-2018 in and District Health Society is under statutory obligation to comply the order of the Hon'ble High Court as well instruction of



the State Health
Society Bihar, Patna

(iii) For issuance of any other writ (s)
Order (s) /direction (s) upon the respondents
Specially respondent no. 5 and 6 for
which the petitioner be found entitled
to in the factual matrix of the case and
being Lowest rate quoter L1 and L2 in
Tende process.”
