5 21-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects within three weeks. In the eventuality of
non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office
will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B,
201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner along with other co-accused is said to have
tortured the deceased for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. He submits that petitioner is the married sister-in-law of



the deceased and husband of the deceased is already in judicial custody. He submits that there is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioner. He submits that petitioner is a permanent resident and there are no chances of her absconding from the course of justice. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Phulparas P.S. Case No. 240 of 2020, G.R. No.901/2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
