ORAL ORDER

4 11-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Bairiya P.S. Case No. 459 of 2020 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. The alleged recovery has been made from Chath Ghat in village Laukariya whereas the petitioners are the resident of village Bheriharwa. They have no concern with the alleged recovery of foreign liquor. Further he submits that the alleged seized motorcycles do not belong to the



petitioners.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Bairiya P.S. Case No. 459 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
