ORAL ORDER

2 22-07-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs :-

“ For issuance of a writ in the nature of writ of mandamus commanding the respondent authorities especially the respondent no. 4 for removal of encroachment on Govt. Land (Gramin Payain) pertaining to Thana no. 212, Khata no. 397 & 501 & 233 having Khesra no. 66, 44 & 45 respectively having Area-1 Acre 49 decimals & 0.81 decimals & 0.79 decimals respectively as the respondent no. 4 despite order dated 18.06.2019 of respondent no. 2 is sitting tight over the matter causing utmost hardships to the petitioner and other co-



*villagers as the encroached land is outlet for
30-40 families of the village.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Karpi, District-Arwal i.e. the respondent no. 4, for taking appropriate action under the provisions of the ***Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956.***

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 4 and in case, appropriate petition is filed by the petitioner under ***Section 6(1) of Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956,*** within a period of four weeks from today, the respondent no. 4 shall examine the same and pass necessary orders, in accordance with law after hearing the affected parties, within a period of 12 weeks, thereafter.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
