2 21-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 414 and some other allied Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been made accused in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, who was arrested on the spot with incriminating articles. It is submitted that though the seized vehicle belongs to this petitioner but the same was given to co-accused, Rupesh and Ranjit for travel purposes in good faith. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts of the case and nature of accusation against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/ surrender within a period of six weeks from today shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub divisional Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Goh PS case No. 150/2020, subject to conditions laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr. P. C.
