Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Madanpur P.S. Case No. 31/2021 registered for the offence

punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and

Excise Act, 2016.

The allegation, as per the First Information

Report, is that the Police on getting secret information,

intercepted a truck and upon seeing the Police Party 5-7

accused persons fled away. However, 5180 litres of illicit

spirit was recovered from the said truck. The name of the



petitioner has come to light based upon the information received by the Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence in the manner alleged and he has falsely been implicated in this case on the basis of secret information received by the Police. Learned counsel referring to paragraph-7 of the bail petition submits that the petitioner is not the owner of the truck and he is in custody since 11.5.2021.

Regards being had to the submission made by the parties and taking into consideration the materials on record, the fact that petitioner is not the owner of the truck, he is in custody since 11.5.2021, no illicit liquor/spirit has been recovered from possession of the petitioner, and charge sheet has already been submitted, I am inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.40,000/- (Forty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J. II-cum-



Spl. Judge, Aurangabad, in connection with Madanpur P.S.
Case No. 31 of 2021 subject to the condition that the
petitioner will be well represented on each date in the trial
and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail
bonds will be liable to be cancelled.
