Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the F.I.R., the allegation is that dead-body of informant's husband was found lying in water under the bridge and petitioner alongwith other co-accused persons have been made accused on suspicion.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that save & except suspicion, there is nothing against this petitioner. There is no eye-witness to the alleged occurrence. Some of the other similarly situated co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.



Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 1st , Udakishunganj, Madhepura / concerned court in connection with Alamnagar (Ratwara O.P.) P.S. Case No. 154 of 2015, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
