2 05-08-2022 The present writ petition has been filed virtually for enforcement of an order dated 22.6.1992 passed in Encroachment Case No. 4/1992-1993 by the Circle Officer, Mohaniya (Kaimur). At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabhua for redressal of his grievance regarding removal of the encroachment in question.
