Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner no.2 is arrested, hence he prays to withdraw his bail application.

Prayer allowed.

The bail application of the petitioner no.2 is dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioner seek bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Basopatti P.S. Case No.164 of 2021 instituted for the offences under Sections 272, 273, 34 of the Indian Penal Code & Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.
