ORAL ORDER

2 20-06-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove
all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within one month.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Khajauli P.S. Case No. 105 of 2020, registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 354 (B), 379, 448, 380,
504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation, the present petitioner along with seven
named accused persons came to the house of the informant and asked
her as to why they had built a house on the land belonging to them.
The accused persons assaulted the informant and when her husband
Ramlobhit Yadav came to rescue her, the petitioner inflicted *garansa*
blow on his head and co-accused Lalu Kumar inflicted rod blow on



the head of the husband of the informant. He became badly injured and fell on the ground.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that there is land dispute between the parties. There is case and counter case and the members of petitioner side have also sustained injuries.

There is specific allegation against the petitioner that he inflicted *garansa* blow on the head of the informant's husband and that injury was found grievous in nature.

In these circumstances, the petitioner does not deserve privileges of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para-1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
