2 15-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Murliganj P.S. Case No. 355 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Ten persons are said to have assaulted the deceased including the petitioner, who is a lady. The occurrence has taken place due to land dispute and it seems that the name of the petitioner has been given in the F.I.R. out of enmity.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within ten weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, II, Madhepura, in connection with Murliganj P.S. Case No. 355 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
