ORAL ORDER

2 04-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State through virtual court proceedings.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273
and 34 of the Indian Penal Code as well as under Section 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

03 litres of country made liquor has been recovered



from the maize field of the petitioners situated behind the house of Vidyanand Rai (petitioner of Cr. Misc. No.41787 of 2022). The petitioners and other co-accused persons are said to have fled away from the place of occurrence after seeing the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail applications. It is also submitted that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioners.

Petitioners are agree to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each in Bihar State Legal Services Authority bearing Account No.0380000100252472, IFSC Code: PUNB0038000, Punjab National Bank, Patna.

Taking into consideration the fact that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioners, let petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Court No.I, Muzaffarpur in connection



with Minapur P.S. Case No.185 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the further conditions that:

(i) One of the bailors will be their own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or their wife/husband.

(ii) The petitioners shall not indulge themselves in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.
