the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Sonepur P.S. Case No. 363 of 2021 registered for the offence punishable under section 30(a), 38 and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. Petitioners are neither the owner of the vehicles in question nor have any concern with the seized illicit liquor. Petitioners have no criminal

antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing of his personal bond to the satisfaction of 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Saran in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 363 of 2021 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
