2 05-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 379, 384, 386, 308, 504 and 506/34 of the IPC.

It is a case of assault upon the informant by the accused persons and snatching Rs.85,000/- from him also.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the injuries are simple in nature which shows vide Annexure-2 to this petition. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Banka in connection with Banka P.S. Case No. 54 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
